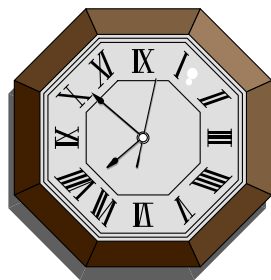

Handicap Pairs and Off Gun Matches

Start Time:	10.00am Saturday 25 th September 2010
Finish time	10.00p.m. Saturday 25 th September for the 12 hour shoot 10.00a.m. Sunday 26 th September. for the 24 hour shoot.
Why:	For fun
How Much:	\$50.00 each person 24 hour shoot or \$25.00 each person 12 hour shoot
Who With:	A partner of your choice

While it would be preferable if they could come to Adelaide, interstate competitors wishing to enter, but unable to come to Adelaide, may be included if they can organise a simultaneous event in their State. Please phone us to find out more.

- The following matches will be conducted in conjunction with each other. These are:

 - Handicapped Pairs Air Rifle – 12 hour shoot and 24 hour shoot. (2 events)
(.177 calibre air rifle in ISSF rules or ISCD rules or Air Rifle Supported TRSA 2010 rules)
 - Individual Off Gun – Air Rifle – ISSF Rules & ISCD Rules – 12 hour shoot and 24 hour shoots
 - Individual Junior Standing Air Rifle – 12 hour shoot and 24 hour shoots
 - Individual Air Rifle Supported – 12 hour and 24 hour shoots

(Note: - Individual matches will be included only where there are at least 2 entrants in the event)
- Prizes will be awarded to each of the winners, in the 12 and 24 hour shoots in the following way:

 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd pairs in the handicap pairs competition, irrespective of guns used or ISCD/ISSF /TRSA Rules.
 - 1st place off rifle in each grade in the individual air rifle (ISSF Rules). (Org Committee to determine grades)
 - 1st Junior Air Rifle – ISSF Rules (provided at least 2 entrants)
 - 1st place off rifle ISCD Air Rifle (provided at least 2 entrants)
 - 1st place off rifle Air Rifle Supported (provided at least 2 entrants)
 - **EVERY ENTRANT FINISHING THE MATCH WILL BE PRESENTED WITH A CERTIFICATE**
- The handicap will be allocated to each person and will be added at the end of each round (1 x 60 shot match each so results can be compared at any given time. Unused handicap will not be carried over to the next round.
- Each 60 shot match will have a time limit of 90 minutes, which will include partner changeover time. Partners will change every 90 minutes.
- Shooters must alternate each 60 shot match with their partners.
- The bay allocated will be shared with your partner in alternating details for the duration of both the 12 and 24 hour competitions.
- With the exception of the handicap and time limit, the ISSF /ISCD /TRSA rules will apply.
