## STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS MAY 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> 2010

TO BE HELD ON THE TARGET RIFLE SOUTH AUSTRALIA INC. RANGE AT  
132 Wingfield Road, Wingfield.

### ENTRY FEES

As shown on the entry form, entry fees vary in accordance with each event.

### RULES:

1. Entrants must be registered members of TRSA Inc or a State Association affiliated with Target Rifle Australia.
2. The ISSF/TRA rules, and ISCD/ISSF rules will apply
3. Grades will be based on the State Averages listing where possible, otherwise they will be based on scores provided. The number of grades in each event will be determined by entries.
4. Juniors will be under the age of 21 years on Dec.31<sup>st</sup> 2010
5. Veterans will be 56 years or over on Dec 31<sup>st</sup> 2010.
6. Presentation of medals will be made as follows: –
  - Gold, Silver and Bronze medals where there are 5 or more competitors in a grade/event.
  - Gold and Silver only where there are only 4 competitors in a grade/event
  - Gold only where only 3 competitors are in a grade/event.
  - Where less than 3 competitors in an event, certificates will be given
 The State **Open Champions** of the 50 metres, Air Rifle, 3x40 and 3x20, after the Finals in these events will each receive a cash prize of \$50.00 and their names will be encribed on the Perpetual Trophies.
7. In the event of a dispute of any kind, the matter will be passed to the competition jury whose decision will be final.
8. Payment of entry fee indicates acceptance of the Competition rules.

### PROGRAM:

#### Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup> :

- 8.00 am. 50 Metres Prone (English Match) (2<sup>nd</sup> squad at 9.30p.m.)**  
Incorporates events for ISSF/TRA Rules &, ISCD/ISSF Disabled rules  
Shot as 1x 60 shot match in 1 hour 15 minutes. Medals will be presented in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Men, Women, Veteran, Junior, and B (etc) Grades, and also to Disabled events under ISCD Rules. Where practicable, Men, Women and Disabled competitors will be squadded together.
- 12.00p.m. Final to determine the Open 50 metres Prone State Championship winner (ISSF Rules)**  
Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00.  
(The top SA shooter in the Final will be the State Representative in the TRA Nationals 50m Champion of Champions event)
- 1.00 p.m. Men's Air Rifle (60 shots) (ISSF Rules)**  
**Women's Air Rifle (40 shots) (ISSF Rules)**  
**Disabled Air Rifle Standing (40 shots Women, 60 shots Men) (ISCD Rules)**  
Shot as 1x40 shot match for Women in 1 hour 15 minutes and 1 x 60 shot match for Men in 1 hour 45 mins  
Where practicable Men, Women and Disabled competitors will be squadded together. If a second detail is required, this will be at 10.30a.m. and consideration will be given to shooters' squadding in other events. Medals will be presented, in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Disabled Men and Women, and to ISSF - Grades and Juniors & Veterans (Men and Women).
- 3.30p.m. Women's Final Air Rifle – Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Women's Championship**  
**4.00p.m. Men's Final Air Rifle – Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Men's Championship.**
- 4.45p.m. 10 shot Shootoff (using Finals format) between 1<sup>st</sup> SA Woman and 1<sup>st</sup> SA Man to determine the Open SA Air Rifle Champion – Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00.**  
(The top shooter in this Final will be the State Representative in the TRA Nationals Air Rifle Champion of Champions event)

#### Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup> :

- 8.00 a.m. 20 Metres Prone (other start times at 10.00, 1.00, and 3.00)**  
60 shot match shot in 3 x 20 shot details of 30 mins each. Medals will be presented, in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Open, Junior, Veteran, B (etc.) Grades and Disabled shooters in ISCD prone position.
- 8.00 a.m. 3x40 Three Position Championship**  
Incorporates events for ISSF/TRA Rules, and ISCD/ISSF Disabled rules)  
3x40 Championship and the 3x40 Disabled Championship will be shot as 40 shots in each of the prone, standing & kneeling positions, with separate time limits for each position. Medals will be presented, in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Men, Women, Veteran, Junior, B (etc) Grades and also Disabled under ISCD Rules.
- 12.00 p.m. 3x40 Final** (to determine the Open 3x40 Three Position Championship winner (ISSF Rules)  
Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00.
- 1.00 p.m. 3x20 Championship**  
Incorporates events for ISSF/TRA Rules, and ISCD/ISSF Disabled rules)  
3x20 Championship and the 3x20 Disabled Championship to be shot as 1x60 shot match in 2 hrs 15 mins. Medals will be presented, in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Women, Men, Veteran, Junior, B (etc) Grades and Disabled under ISCD rules
- 4.00 p.m. 3x20 Final** (to determine the Open 3x20 Three Position winner (ISSF rules)  
Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00.
