ENTRY FEES

As shown on the entry form, entry fees vary in accordance with each event.

RULES:

1. Entrants must be registered members of TRSA Inc or a State Association affiliated with Target Rifle Australia.
2. Rules for each match are shown on the entry form and include TRA Benchrest Rules, TRSA Benchrest Rules for Class 1 rifles; TRSA "Any Sights" Rules and TRSA Air Rifle Supported Rules-2010.
3. Please note that In events shot under the TRSA "Any Sights" rules, sights may include the usual peep sight, or the use of eagle eyes, diopters and/or telescopic sights of any power. Air Rifle Supported, in accordance with the TRSA 2010 rules, is shot with an air rifle that conforms to ISSF rules and from a standing or sitting position using a standing rest for the rifle.
4. Grades will be based on the State Ranking List where possible, otherwise they will be based on scores provided. The number of grades in each event will be determined by entries in that event.
5. Juniors will be under the age of 21 years and Veterans over the age of 56 years on Dec.31st 2012
6. Presentation of medals will be made as follows: –
 - Gold, Silver and Bronze medals where there are 5 or more competitors in a grade/event.
 - Gold and Silver only where there are only 4 competitors in a grade/event
 - Gold only where only 3 competitors are in a grade/event.
 - Where less than 3 competitors in an event, certificates will be given.
7. In the event of a dispute of any kind, the matter will be passed to the competition jury whose decision will be final.
9. Payment of entry fee indicates acceptance of the Competition rules.

Benchrest - 20 Metres

Classes 1,2,& 3; Additional start times at 10.00, 12.00, 2.00 & 4.00

This 60 shot match will be shot as 2x30 shot sections of 45 minutes each with a short target change break between each section. Sighting shots will be allowed between each 30 shot string. Medals to Open, Junior and B Grade in each class depending on the number of entries.

10.00 a.m.

Any Sights 50 Metres Prone

TRSA rules apply - this 60 shot match will be shot as 3 x 20 shot sections of 30 minutes each, with a 10 minute break between each section. Sighting shots will be allowed between each 20 shot string. Any Sights are permitted –eg peep sights, telescopic sights, diopters or eagle eyes etc. Medals to Open, Juniors and Veterans

12.00p.m.

Class 1 50 Metres Prone

60 shots prone, shot in 3x20 shot sections of 30 minutes each with a 10 minute break between each section. Sighting shots allowed between each 20 shot string. TRSA rules for Class 1 rifles includes 12 power sights, sling may be used in this position. Medals to Open only (subject to entries.)

2.00p.m.

Air Rifle Supported

TRSA-2010 rules apply – match is a 60 shot, time 1 hour 30 minutes.

(Note – please refer to the TRSA 2010 rules for this match - shot with an air rifle that conforms to ISSF rules and from a standing or sitting position using a standing rest for the rifle - . Medals to Open, Junior and B Grade, depending on the number of entries.

Sunday:

10.00 a.m.

Benchrest Class 1 50m (max weight 3.5kg – scope limit of 12 power – TRSA Rules apply)

Shot as 1x 60 shot match in 1 hour 15 minutes. Medals will be given to Open, Junior & B Grade depending on the number of entries.

11.30 a.m.

Benchrest Class 2 50m (max weight 4.5 kg – no scope limit – TRA Rules to apply)

Shot as 1x 60 shot match in 1 hour 15 minutes. Medals will be given to Open, Junior & B Grade depending on the number of entries

1.00p.m.

Benchrest Class 3 50m (max weight 8kg – no scope limit) - TRA Rules to apply

Shot as 1x 60 shot match in 1 hour 15 minutes. Medals will be given to,Open, Junior & B Grade
