ENTRY FEES

As shown on the entry form, entry fees vary in accordance with each event.

RULES:

- Entrants must be registered members of TRSA Inc or a State Association affiliated with Target Rifle Australia.
- The ISSF/TRA rules, and ISCD/ISSF rules will apply
- Grades will be based on the State Rankings where possible, otherwise they will be based on scores provided. The number of grades in each event will be determined by entries.
- Juniors will be under the age of 21 years on Dec.31st 2012
- Veterans will be 56 years or over on Dec 31st 2012.
- Presentation of medals will be made as follows: –
 - Gold, Silver and Bronze medals where there are 5 or more competitors in a grade/event.
 - Gold and Silver only where there are only 4 competitors in a grade/event
 - Gold only where only 3 competitors are in a grade/event.
 - Where less than 3 competitors in an event, certificates will be given
- The State **Open Champions** of the 50 metres prone, Air Rifle, 3x40 and 3x20, after the Finals in these events will each receive a cash prize of \$50.00 and their names will be engraved on the Perpetual Trophies.
- In the event of a dispute of any kind, the matter will be passed to the competition jury whose decision will be final.
- Payment of entry fee indicates acceptance of the Competition rules.

Saturday:

9.00 a.m.

20 Metres Prone (other start times as required)

60 shot match shot in 3 x 20 shot details of 30 mins each.

Medals will be presented, in accordance with Rule (6) above, to Open, B & C Grades, Junior, Veteran, and Disabled shooters in ISCD prone position.

11.30 a.m.

Air Rifle

Where practicable Men, Women and Disabled competitors will be squadded together. If a second detail is required, this will be at 9.00a.m. and consideration will be given to shooters' squadding in other events.

Women's Air Rifle (40 shots) (ISSF Rules) (shot as 1x40 shot match in 1 hour 15 mins.)

2.00p.m. Women's Final Air Rifle – Medals will be presented in accordance with Rule 6 above for 1st, 2nd and 3rd after the final plus Grades, Junior & Veteran in Women's Championship.

Men's Air Rifle (60 shots) (ISSF Rules) (shot as 1x60 shot match in 1 hour 45 mins.)

3.00p.m. Men's Final Air Rifle – Medals will be presented in accordance with Rule 6 above for 1st, 2nd and 3rd after the final plus Grades, Junior & Veteran in Men's Championship.

4.00p.m. The South Australian Open Air Rifle Champion will be determined after a 10 shot Shootoff (using Finals format) between the 1st SA Woman and 1st SA Man – The Winner of Open Championship has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00. (The SA Champion will be the State Representative in the 2012 TRA Nationals Air Rifle Champion of Champions event.)

Disabled Air Rifle Standing (40 shots Women, 60 shots Men) (ISCD Rules)

Shot as 1x40 shot match for Women in 1 hour 15 minutes and 1 x 60 shot match for Men in 1 hour 45 mins

A final will be conducted for ISCD shooters if more than 2 competitors. Presentation of awards for ISCD competitors in accordance with Rule 6 above.

Sunday:

8.00 a.m.

3x20 Three Position Championships

Incorporates events for ISSF and ISCD Disabled rules, entry by both men and women is encouraged

3x20 ISSF Championship and the 3x20 ISCD (Disabled) Championships will be shot in conjunction – time limit 2 hours 15 minutes for each.

11.00.

3x20 Final (to determine the 3x20 Three Position winner (ISSF rules) Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00. Medals will be presented based on results after the finals in accordance with Rule (6) to Open, Grades, Junior and Veteran shooters.

A final will be conducted for ISCD shooters if more than 2 competitors. Presentation of awards for ISCD competitors in accordance with Rule 6 above.

1.30p.m.

50 Metres Prone (English Match) (overflow squad if required at 12.00p.m. for B/C grade shooters)

Incorporates events for ISSF/TRA Rules &, ISCD/ISSF Disabled rules

Shot as 1 x 60 shot match in 1 hour 15 minutes.

Medals will be presented in accordance with Rule (6) above; in the ISSF events, to Men & Women (based on the qualifying scores), B (etc) Grades, Veteran & Junior; and to Disabled events under ISCD Rules.

3.30p.m.

Final to determine the Open 50 metres Prone State Championship winner (ISSF Rules)

Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00.

(The top SA shooter after the Final will be the State Representative in the 2012 TRA Nationals 50m Champion of Champions event because of the change of timing of this year's Championship.)

A final will be conducted for ISCD shooters if more than 2 competitors. Presentation of awards for ISCD competitors in accordance with Rule 6 above.

Monday:

10.30 a.m.

3x40 Three Position Championships

Incorporates events for ISSF and ISCD Disabled rules

3x40 ISSF Championship and the 3x40 ISCD (Disabled) Championship will be shot as 40 shots in each of the prone, standing & kneeling positions, with separate time limits for each position.

3.00 p.m.

3x40 Final (to determine the 3x40 Three Position Championship winner (ISSF Rules) Winner has name on Perpetual Trophy and receives \$50.00. Medals will be presented based on results after the finals in accordance with Rule (6) to Open, Grades, Junior and Veteran shooters.

A final will be conducted for ISCD shooters if more than 2 competitors. Presentation of awards for ISCD competitors in accordance with Rule 6 above.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to make alterations to the above program where necessary.
