

2020 Friendly Competition Series - Postal

Now that we can get back to the range, but not yet travel interstate, we will run a series of Friendly Postal competitions. We will run as many series of these competitions as required while the travel restrictions remain in place, and we will re-assess after each series.

Series 1 will run during July and August.

The purpose of these competitions is for everyone to stay connected to each other by having a friendly competition series and something interesting to train for. It is open to all TRA members who shoot air rifle, three position and prone. This competition is not official or run by Shooting Australia, it is just part of athlete preparation during challenging times.

Anyone interested in being involved can email Petr Kurka petr@shootingaustralia.org to register. On registering, you will receive a link to the TeamApp so you can keep track of scores, which will be uploaded to the app after each competition.

Rules

10m Air Rifle (Open category)

There will be five 60 shot air rifle competitions **with the best three scores to count for prizes** (to be determined). Athletes are encouraged to shoot all five rounds.

We will also hold a final where everyone shoots all 24 shots (no elimination), and the total score will be counted. Finals can be shot on the same firing points as the competition, with finals and time calls by coach/official.

The competition is to be shot on electronic targets or on paper but scored by decimal using a scoring machine.

Shooting should be supervised and verified by a coach or club member.

Scores to be sent to Petr Kurka petr@shootingaustralia.org and they will be posted on Team App.

The competitions should be run to ISSF Rules. It is preferable if each range can have a set start time for the competitions, with athletes on the firing line together in accordance with your State's social distancing requirements.

50m Three Position (Open category)

50m Prone 60 (Open category)

There will be five competitions. Your decision will be whether you decide for two separate competitions (3p and Prone), or only 3P, or only Prone, or whether you shoot 40 + 60 + 40, where the first 40 shots from the Prone position can be counted in the 3x40. **The best three scores in both events to count for prizes** (to be determined). Athletes are encouraged to shoot all five rounds.

We will also include a 3 Position final where everyone shoots all 45 shots (no elimination), and the total score will be counted. Finals can be shot on the same firing points as the competition, with finals and time calls by coach/official. No separate Finals in Prone.

The competition is to be shot on electronic targets.

Shooting should be supervised and verified by a coach or club member (but speak to Petr or Carrie if you will have problems with this).

Scores to be sent to Petr Kurka petr@shootingaustralia.org and they will be posted on Team App.

The competitions should be run to ISSF Rules with athletes on the firing line together in accordance with your State's social distancing requirements.

Competition Dates

Both of the 50m events can be shot inside a competition window period – scores need to be received by the last day of the window so they can be published on TeamApp.
