Our vision

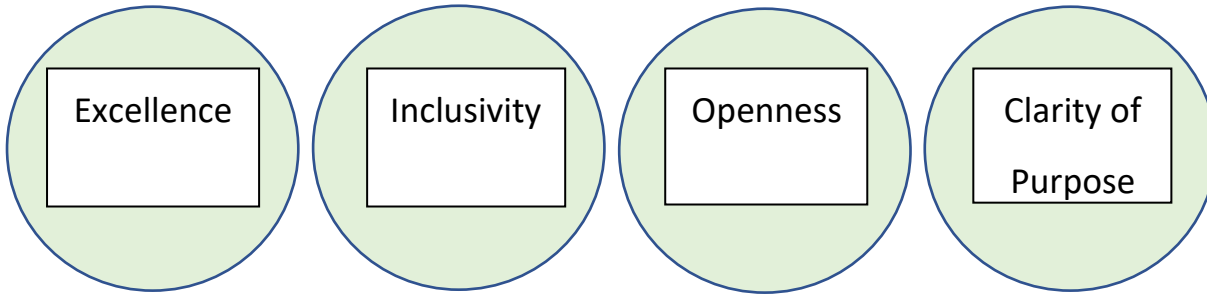

Our Mission Statement:

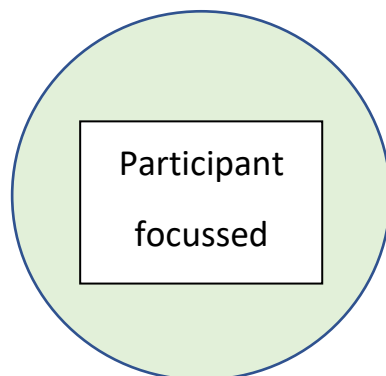
Encourage coordination, cooperation and collaboration amongst the Target Rifle South Australia community.
